**WEEK 9:**

**DAY 2: CHRIST DIED FOR OUR SINS AND ROSE AGAIN**

1 Corinthians 15:1-11

1. We have just two weeks to finish studying 1 Corinthians. I hope you are learning much from these lessons. I also hope you will want to go on studying 1 Corinthians by yourself.

Let us remember the last lesson from I Corinthians 14.

How should all things be done in church?

2. In church all things should be done rightly and in order. Now we go on to 1 Corinthians 15. Today we will learn two big things. Paul said they are of first importance. The shepherd should often preach about these.

- (1) Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures.
- (2) He was raised from the dead according to the scriptures.

Read 1 Corinthians 15:1 to 11 from your Bible now.

As we have learned already, what is the most important thing to preach about?

3. The most important thing to preach about is Jesus dying on the cross. Paul has already taught this. In today's verses, Paul reminded the Corinthians how he preached. He preached to them the gospel of Jesus Christ. It was because Paul preached the gospel that they were saved.

1 Corinthians 15:3:

For I delivered (or gave) to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the scriptures.

4. Jesus died for our sins. Jesus did many things when he was in the world. He gave many good teachings. He gave a good example to follow. But the big thing he did was to die for our sins. He was nailed to the cross for you and me.

5. We can read about the death of Jesus in the Bible. We can read about it in the New Testament. We can also read about it in the Old Testament. The death of Jesus was predicted in the time of the prophets of the Old Testament.

Romans 1:1-2:

... the gospel of God which he promised beforehand through his prophets in the holy Scriptures.

Isaiah 53:5:

But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement (or punishment) that made us whole, and with his stripes we are healed.

Why did Jesus die on the cross? \_\_\_\_\_

6. He did this for our sins. We can read about it in the New Testament. The prophets also wrote about it in the Old Testament. The prophets said what Jesus would do.

What did the prophets say Jesus would do for our sins? \_\_\_\_\_

7. They wrote that Jesus would die for our sins. This is very important. We are sinful. We have disobeyed God. We should be punished by death for our sins. But God loves us. He sent Jesus to die for our sins. If we repent and receive him as our Saviour, we do not have to die for our sins.

We read about Jesus' death in the New Testament. In what other place can we read about Jesus dying for our sins? \_\_\_\_\_

8. We can read this in the Old Testament. The prophets in the Old Testament told about the time when Jesus would come. They told what Jesus would do.

What is the first big thing Jesus did according to Old Testament scriptures?

9. The first thing he did fulfilling the scriptures was to die for our sins. Jesus died in the way the Old Testament prophets said he would die. And there is something else Jesus did according to Old Testament scriptures.

1 Corinthians 15:4:

. . . that he (Jesus) was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the scriptures.

Jesus died for our sins. Then he was buried. Then what happened? \_\_\_\_\_

10. Three days after Jesus was buried, he rose from the dead.

Do you think the Old Testament tells anything about the resurrection of Jesus?

11. All these things happened according to the scriptures. They are all talked about in the Old Testament. When Peter preached about the resurrection of Jesus, he used the Old Testament. He used the words of David about the resurrection.

Acts 2:24-25, 31:

But God raised him (Jesus) up . . . For David says concerning him . . . For thou wilt not abandon (or leave) my soul in Hades, nor let thy Holy One (Jesus) see corruption . . . for he foresaw and spoke of the resurrection of the Christ.

What happened to Jesus after he was buried according to the scriptures?

12. He rose from the dead. Jesus died and was buried. But God brought him back to life. When Jesus rose, this showed that God accepted the sacrifice of Jesus.

Romans 4:24-25:

It will be reckoned to us who believe in him that raised from the dead Jesus our Lord, who was put to death for our trespasses and raised for our justification (or to make us right).

We read about the resurrection in the New Testament. In what other place can we read about the resurrection of Jesus?

13. We can read about it in the Old Testament. The Old Testament tells what the prophets said would happen to Jesus. The prophets lived a long time before Jesus was born. But God told them to write down what would happen.

Jesus did two things according to the scriptures. Write the first. Then read the second.

14. The first thing Jesus did according to scripture was to die for our sins. He died for your sins and my sins. This is something we should preach about. We should tell people this so we can bring them to Jesus. This is what Paul preached at Corinth. When he did this many people were saved.

15. Jesus rose from the dead. After he rose, he showed himself to many people. Then Jesus went back to heaven. From the time he rose until he went back to heaven was 40 days. During these 40 days, many people saw him.

Take your Bible again and read 1 Corinthians 15:5 to 8. Write three people or groups of people who saw Jesus after his resurrection.

16. You should have written three of these: Cephas (or Peter), the 12 disciples, the 500, James, Paul. These show that Jesus did rise from the dead. He was seen by many people.

Acts 1:3:

Jesus presented himself alive after his passion (or death) by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days, and speaking of the kingdom of God.

**WEEK 9:**

**DAY 3: CHRIST IS THE FIRST FRUIT**

**1 Corinthians 15:12-28**

1. Yesterday we learned that Jesus did two things according to the scriptures?

What are they? (1) \_\_\_\_\_

2. First, Jesus died for our sins. Then he rose from the dead. Today we will learn more from I Corinthians 15 about the resurrection of Jesus.

(1) The resurrection of Jesus is like the first fruit.

(2) Christians who have died, will also be raised when Jesus returns.

Take your Bible now and read 1 Corinthians 15:12 to 23.

3. Some of the Corinthians were saying that there is no resurrection from the dead. Paul was troubled about this. He wrote them about it. He said that if there is no resurrection, then Christ did not rise. And if Christ did not rise then our faith and preaching are nothing. But Christ did rise. And the dead in Christ will rise too.

1 Corinthians 15:22-23

For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ.

From this verse, what does Paul say the resurrection of Jesus is like?

4. Paul says it is like the first fruits. The Jewish people had a special day each year at harvest time. When the harvest was ready, they gathered the first part of it. They took it to the temple to give to God. This was a way of thanking him for the rains and the sunshine. They were also thanking God for what would follow. The first fruit was always given to God. It was just part of the harvest. It was a sign that more harvest was coming.

In 1 Corinthians 15, what does Paul say is like the first fruit? \_\_\_\_\_

5. Paul says that the resurrection of Jesus is like the first fruit. When a man wants a harvest, he must plant seed in the ground. Then he must care for it. Later the harvest comes.

John 12:24:

Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.



Who was like a seed, was buried and died, and then became the first fruit?

6. This verse is talking about Jesus. Jesus was like a seed that was planted in the ground. Jesus died. He was buried. Then he rose from the dead.

What does Paul say the resurrection of Jesus is like? \_\_\_\_\_

7. Paul says it is like the first fruit. The Jewish people always gave the first part of the harvest to the Lord. They were thanking him for the harvest that would follow. Jesus is like the first fruit. He was the first person to overcome death.

But other people will be raised from the dead too. This chapter is talking about Christians who will be raised from the dead.

1 Corinthians 15:20:

But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep.

8. This is a big question. Some people say that his spirit goes to a special place. Some say that the spirit goes to be with the ancestors. Some say that the Lord takes the person.

Today we will learn what happens to Christians who die. We all know people who were Christians but who have died. We have buried them in the ground. Christians who are buried will be raised to life. They will be raised as Jesus was raised. This will happen when Jesus comes again.

9. The resurrection of Jesus is like the first fruit. Jesus was the first person to overcome death. But others will also rise from the dead.

1 Corinthians 15:23:

Christ the first fruits, then at his coming, those who belong to Christ (will be raised).

When will Christians who have died be raised to life again? \_\_\_\_\_

10. This will happen when Jesus comes to earth again. When Jesus went to heaven, he said he would return to earth. Some day Jesus will come as he said.

1 Corinthians 15:51-52:

Lo! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable (or not able to die again), and we shall be changed.

What kind of people will be raised when Jesus comes back to earth? \_\_\_\_\_

11. When Jesus comes back, those who belong to Christ will be raised. It will be those who are "dead in Christ." It will be those who are saved but have died. They will be raised to life again.

1 Thessalonians 4:16:

For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the archangel's call, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.

What does Paul say the resurrection of Jesus is like? \_\_\_\_\_

12. It is like the first fruit. Jesus rose from the dead. He was the first to do this. We believe in resurrection. If we did not believe this, then we could not believe in Jesus. We could not believe that our sins are forgiven. And our preaching would be nothing.

1 Corinthians 15:16-17:

For if the dead are not raised, then Christ has not been raised. If Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins.

Since we believe, what do we know will happen to the dead in Christ when Christ comes?

---

13. They will be raised. They will be brought back to life. They will go to be with the Lord. This is a wonderful thing. A funeral is a sad time. We do not want to see people die. We do not like to talk about death. But Paul has good news for us. When Christians die, there is hope. We bury people who die. But Christians who are buried will be brought back to life. They will receive new bodies.

When will the dead in Christ be raised to life again? \_\_\_\_\_

14. This will happen when Jesus comes back to earth. Jesus is like the first fruit of the harvest. But he is not the only fruit. Jesus was the first to rise from the dead. But he is not the only one who will be raised to life. When Jesus comes again there will be many who are raised to life.

What kind of people will be raised to life when Jesus comes again? \_\_\_\_\_

15. The Bible says that the dead in Christ will rise. They will go to be with the Lord. This is the hope of all Christians.

It is hard to think about death. We want Jesus to come back to earth before we die. But people grow old and die. When Christians die, they do not need to be sad. They can have hope. Jesus will come back to earth again. When he comes, those who are dead in Christ will go to be with him.

**WEEK 9:**

**DAY 4: CHRIST WILL GIVE THE KINGDOM TO THE FATHER**

1 Corinthians 15:20-34

1. Yesterday we learned about Christians who have died.

What did Paul say the resurrection of Jesus is like? \_\_\_\_\_

When Christ comes again, what will happen to the dead in Christ? \_\_\_\_\_

2. The resurrection of Jesus is like the first fruit. Jesus was the first to rise from the dead. Christians who have died will be raised to life when Jesus returns.

Today we will learn an important truth about the end time.

When he has defeated all his enemies,  
Christ will give the kingdom to God the Father

Take your Bible now and read 1 Corinthians 15:20-28.

3. When Jesus returns, many things will happen. One thing is that the dead in Christ will be raised. We will learn more about this tomorrow. But there is something else that will happen at the end.

1 Corinthians 15:24:

Then comes the end, when he (Jesus) delivers (or gives) the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule and every authority and power.

From this verse, what will Christ do after destroying every power? \_\_\_\_\_

4. He will give the kingdom to the Father. We read much about the kingdom in the Bible. The kingdom is made up of those who have repented and received Jesus as their Saviour. It is made up of those whom Jesus has brought back from sin to God. Sometimes it is called the kingdom of God. Sometimes it is called the kingdom of heaven.

Who will give the kingdom to God at the end? \_\_\_\_\_

5. This is something that Jesus will do. God sent Jesus into the world. He sent him to save people. He sent Jesus to bring people back from sin.

In the beginning, Adam and Eve had fellowship with God. They belonged to God. Then sin came. People went far away from God. God sent Jesus to bring people back to God. The kingdom is made up of those whom Jesus has brought back.

To whom will Jesus give the kingdom? \_\_\_\_\_

6. Jesus will give it to God the Father. He will do this after he has destroyed his enemies. But first, Jesus must destroy all the enemies. He must destroy all powers and authorities.

1 Corinthians 15:25:

For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet.

What will Jesus give to the Father when he has defeated all his enemies?

7. He will give the kingdom to God the Father. When he came into the world, he came to preach about the kingdom. He came to build the kingdom.

Mark 1:14-15:

Now after John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of God, and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent, and believe in the gospel."

Who came to build the kingdom? \_\_\_\_\_

8. Jesus did this. Jesus came to preach about how people could come back to God. He came to bring them back to God. God sent Jesus into the world. God wanted people to come back to fellowship with himself.

Revelation 5:9-10:

they sang a new song, saying, "Worthy art thou . . . for thou wast slain and by thy blood didst ransom (or buy back) men for God from every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and hast made them a kingdom.

From this verse, what did Jesus do to bring people back to God? \_\_\_\_\_

9. Jesus died or was killed. He bought men with his blood. Jesus wanted to make a kingdom. To make this kingdom he died on the cross. He gave his blood to buy us back. Now when we receive Jesus, he makes us part of his kingdom. We who receive Jesus are his kingdom.

When Jesus has defeated all his enemies, what will he do with this kingdom?

10. He will give it to God the Father. He will give to God the people whom he has saved. This is what Jude wrote about it.

Jude 24:

Now to him who is able to keep you from falling and to present (or give) you without blemish before the presence of his glory with rejoicing. . .

When will Jesus give the kingdom to God the Father?

---

11. Jesus will do this when he has defeated all his enemies. He must defeat every rule and every power.

1 Corinthians 15:26:

The last enemy to be destroyed is death.

From this verse, what is the last enemy which Jesus will destroy?

---

12. Death is an enemy. It is the last enemy to be defeated. People are afraid to die. Death came into the world because of sin. Adam and Eve died because they sinned. But Jesus came to defeat death. When Jesus rose from the dead, he defeated death in his own body. Soon he will defeat death in the bodies of all his children.

1 Corinthians 15:54:

When the perishable (or that which dies) puts on the imperishable (or that which cannot die), and the mortal puts on immortality, then shall come to pass the saying that is written: "Death is swallowed up in victory."

When Jesus has defeated all his enemies, what will he do with his kingdom?

13. Jesus will give the kingdom to God the Father. He will give to God all those who have been saved. He will give to God all those who have been brought back to God. Jesus has power over death. He showed this when he rose from the dead.

When Jesus comes back, what will happen to the dead in Christ? \_\_\_\_\_

14. They will be raised when Jesus comes back. This will show that Jesus has power over death. Death is the last enemy. Jesus will defeat the last enemy.

When Jesus has defeated all his enemies, what will he do with his kingdom?

15. Jesus will give the kingdom to God the Father. This will be a sign that he has finished his work. All the enemies of God will be defeated. All things will be under the rule of Jesus.

Revelation 11:15:

The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he shall reign for ever and ever.

16. If you have repented and received Jesus, you are part of the kingdom. When Jesus comes back to earth, he will take you. He will give you to God. This is something we should thank God for. We are not good enough to be given to God. But because of what Christ has done for us, we can be given to God.

Before finishing this lesson, stop and thank God for this promise which we have.

**WEEK 9:**  
**DAY 5: OUR BODIES WILL BE CHANGED**  
**1 Corinthians 15:35-55**

1. We have now learned what will happen at the end. Christ will destroy all his enemies.

Then what will Christ do with his kingdom? \_\_\_\_\_

2. Christ will give the kingdom to God the Father. A few days ago, we talked about the resurrection of the dead. We will learn more about this today. We will learn two things about the new bodies we will receive:

- (1) They will not grow old or die.
- (2) They will be spiritual bodies.

What will happen to the dead in Christ when Jesus returns? \_\_\_\_\_

3. The dead in Christ will be raised. They will be given new life. They will get new bodies. People have many questions about the resurrection of the body. Perhaps people sometimes ask you about this.

1 Corinthians 15:35:

But some one will ask, "How are the dead raised? With what kind of body do they come?"

When will the dead in Christ receive new bodies? \_\_\_\_\_

4. This will happen when Jesus returns. When someone dies, we bury him in the ground. But if that person is a Christian, he will be raised to life again. But what will his new body be like? The Bible tells us.

Open your Bible now. Read 1 Corinthians 15:42-44. Write some things that these verses tell about our new bodies.

5. There are four things in these verses about our new bodies. This is what you could have written: (1) They will not die. (2) They are raised in glory. (3) They are raised in power. (4) They are raised as spiritual bodies. All of these things are important. But we have chosen just two to talk about today.

(1) They will not grow old or die.

(2) They will be spiritual bodies.

Now take your Bible again. Read 1 Corinthians 15:45 to 54.

---

6. Paul says that a person who dies is like a seed. When his body is buried, the seed is planted. A farmer who plants seed waits for the plants to grow. He expects new life to come. In the same way we know that a Christian who is buried will rise again.

1 Corinthians 15:36-37:

What you sow does not come to life unless it dies. And what you sow is not the body which is to be, but a bare kernel (or seed), perhaps of wheat or of some other grain.

Do you think the body which is raised is like the body which was buried?

---

7. The new body will not be the same. It will be different. Our bodies will be changed. We will have new bodies when we are raised to life again.

1 Corinthians 15:51-52:

Lo! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall all be changed.

When will our bodies be changed so they will not grow old or die? \_\_\_\_\_

---

8. This will happen when Jesus returns. Let us think about a seed that you plant. Does the seed look like what grows out of the ground? No. The seed does not look like the plant. It is the same with our bodies. When we are raised, we will have new bodies. The first way in which our bodies will be different is this: They will not grow old or die.

Ngugi went to the market and bought some bananas. But when he got home, he was called away. He left the bananas in his house. When he returned four days later, the bananas were bad. They had grown old and rotted.

What things will be changed when Christ returns so they will not grow old or die?

---

9. Our bodies will be changed. When Jesus comes, we will have different bodies. Those who have died will be raised. Those who are still alive will also be changed.

What will our new bodies not do? \_\_\_\_\_

10. They will not grow old or die. Look at your body. When you were young, you had much strength. You could walk a long way. You could work hard. As you get older your body becomes weaker. You cannot work so long. You lose some of your hair. You cannot see so well. But this will be changed.

1 Corinthians 15:42:

So it is with the resurrection of the dead. What is sown is perishable (or dies), what is raised is imperishable (or cannot die).

When will Christians get new bodies that will not grow old or die? \_\_\_\_\_

11. This will happen when Christ returns. We will get new bodies. We will be changed. This will happen quickly. It will happen in a moment. God will give us new bodies which are spiritual. They will not be like the bodies we have now.

1 Corinthians 15:44:

It is sown a physical (or earthly) body, it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a physical body, there is also a spiritual body.

What is the first way our new bodies will be different?

(2) They will be spiritual bodies.

12. The first difference is that our new bodies will not grow old or die. They will go on forever. They will not grow weak. They will not get tired. They will not die. But this is not the only difference.

Your body now is a body of flesh or of the earth. Will your new body be a body of flesh?

13. Your new body will not be of flesh. It will be spiritual. It will not have bones and blood like your body has now. In these verses, Paul talked about Adam and Christ. We received our earthly bodies from Adam. But we will receive our new bodies from Christ.

1 Corinthians 15:49:

Just as we have borne the image of the man of dust (who was Adam), we shall also bear the image of the man of heaven (who is Christ).

When will we get our new spiritual bodies? \_\_\_\_\_

14. This will happen when Christ returns. Jesus is coming back to earth. When he comes, those who have died will get new bodies. Those who are alive will also be changed.

1 John 3:2:

Beloved, we are God's children now; it does not yet appear what we shall be, but we know that when he appears we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.
