

WEEK 1: GOD'S PLAN FOR MARRIAGE

DAY 1: WHY GOD BEGAN MARRIAGE

1. Marriage is an important part of our lives today. It is very important to you and me. On the day of your wedding you had many plans for the future. Perhaps you remember how you felt.

2. Those were your reasons for marriage. Everyone has his own good plans for his marriage. But some of these good plans fail. And troubles come in the marriage.

3. Marriages can have troubles. We need help with our marriages. To get help, let us go to God who is the Beginner of marriage.

In your Bible read Genesis 2:18-24. Put a mark like this ✓ on the line when you have read these verses.

4. In these verses we see the beginning of marriage. Today we will learn the two reasons why God planned marriage:

- (1) Because it was not good for man to be alone.
- (2) Because man needed a helper fit for him.

Genesis 2:18:

Then the Lord God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone: I will make a helper fit for him."

5. It was not good for man to be alone. We have read in the Bible that God gave many animals to be with Adam. The animals could serve him. But none of them could be a friend to share life with him.

Genesis 2:19-20:

So out of the ground the Lord God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to the man to see what he would call them; and whatever the man called every living creature, that was its name. The man gave names to all cattle, and to the birds of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for the man there was not found a helper fit for him.

Who was alone even though he had animals with him? _____

6. The man was alone. This was Adam whom God had made. He had donkeys, cattle, goats, dogs, lions, and hens with him. But he was still alone. He had needs which could not be met by animals. He needed someone to talk with. He needed someone to share things with. He needed someone to work with. He needed someone to collect food with. He needed someone with a body like his.

If you have had needs like these, how did you feel? Write your feeling.

7. Perhaps you felt lonely. That is how Adam felt. These needs were important to Adam. They are important to us too. God planned to do something for Adam. It is true that by marriage God planned for man and wife to have children. But having children is not the main reason for marriage. The biggest reason is that man and wife have each other to share life with.

Genesis 2:18:

Then the Lord God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper fit for him."

8. God said he would make a helper fit for him. In this way God began marriage.

9. First, it was not good for man to be alone. But there was no helper found among the animals. The animals served and obeyed Adam. But they were not helpers which fitted him and his needs. Adam needed someone who was right for him.

10. There were many things the animals could not do. A helper fit for Adam could talk with him. She could share things with him. She could work with him. Adam needed a helper fit for him.

11. God began marriage because man needed a helper fit for him. God made this helper from a bone out of Adam's own body. When Adam saw the helper he rejoiced.

Genesis 2:23:

Then the man said, "This at last is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man."

12. Adam gave her the name, Woman. Later she was also called wife. God began the first marriage when he brought this woman to Adam. He gave her to Adam to live with him and be his wife. God did not make another man to be Adam's first, closest friend. Instead, God made a woman. Now Adam had the right kind of helper. She would stay with him all her life. Together they could be complete and meet all the things life would bring them.

2. The reasons are: Because it was not good for man to be alone.
Because man needed a helper fit for him.

God planned that marriage and home life would be good. They would bring blessing to Adam and Eve. God wants your marriage and home life to be a blessing to you. You can have blessing if you follow the teaching which God gives in the Bible. Marriage which follows God's plan is called Christian marriage.

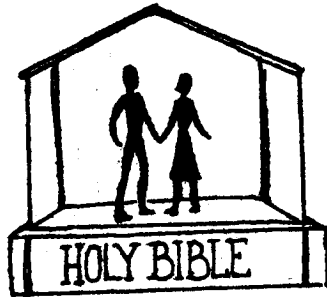
Who created the first marriage? _____

3. God did. He created both men and women. As Creator he knows what will be helpful in living together. He has given us his plan in the Bible. Today and tomorrow we will learn what must be true of husband and wife. Today we learn:

In order for them to have a Christian marriage and home, both husband and wife must be Christians.

What do we call a marriage which follows God's plan?

4. We call it a Christian marriage. Christian marriage is built on obeying the Bible.



Home life is made by the way husband and wife act toward each other every day. As they follow God's word they can live well together. They will have a marriage that is good for both of them.

If two people want to have a Christian marriage, what book should they study?

5. They should study the Bible. There they will find the way to follow Christ's teachings. God will bless them because they are walking in his ways. They will be able to say, "We have a Christian marriage because we are following Christ." They will enjoy fellowship with each other and with God.

Can God bless a marriage where the husband and wife do not obey his word?

6. He cannot bless them, because his way is the only way to blessing. So we must remember today's important teaching. In order for them to have a Christian home, both husband and wife must be Christians.

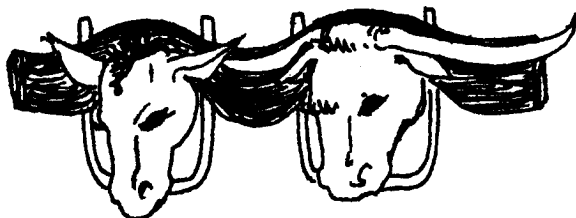
If a marriage follows the teachings of Christ, what can it be called?

7. It can be called a Christian marriage. This means that husband and wife have accepted Jesus as Saviour. It means that both are obeying him. They are living by his power in their lives.

8. The husband and wife must both be believers in Christ. God does not want believers to be married to unbelievers. This is because when two people marry, they become one. It is not right before God for a child of God to marry an unbeliever. It is like yoking together a cow and a donkey to plow the field.



Take your Bible now and read 2 Corinthians 6:14-15. Read the first part of verse 14 again. From this verse, what command does God give to Christians about marriage?

9. God commands Christians not to be mated or married to unbelievers. God asks, "What fellowship has a believer with an unbeliever?" A marriage between a believer and an unbeliever often has problems.

Write one trouble you have seen in a home where one believes: and the other does not.

10. Be ready to talk about this in class. Truly a Christian should marry a Christian. But some people have trouble knowing what a true Christian is. A person may think he is a Christian when he is not.

Some people think they are Christians because they have been baptized. Others think so because their parents are Christians. Others think they are Christians because they attended Christians Schools. Or because they were married in the church. But the Bible tells clearly how to become a Christian.

Acts 16:31:

Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved.

From this verse, what must one do to become a Christian or be saved?

11. He must believe on the Lord Jesus. This means he receives Jesus as his Saviour. He has Christ in his heart. He begins to act in Christian ways. To be a true Christian means to be like Christ. Only Christian people can have Christian marriage and home life. Think about yourself.

When did you accept Jesus as your Saviour?

12. It is good to remember when you became a Christian. A marriage is Christian if husband and wife act like Christ. A marriage cannot be Christian if husband or wife is not Christian. The Christian married to an unbeliever has a hard job. But God does not leave him alone. The Bible has teaching for these people as well. We will study this later.

After a Christian receives Christ, what does it mean to be a Christian?

13. To be a Christian means to be like Christ. Some people think that if they are married in the church, their marriage is Christian. They think it will be Christian no matter what they believe. But this is not true. Both husband and wife must act like Christ. If two Christians are married in the church, this is good. It is a testimony to their faith in Christ. It is good for other Christians to see them married and pray for them.

DAY 3: BOTH MUST FELLOWSHIP WITH GOD

1. Why did God begin marriage?

2. God planned marriage to be a help and blessing to us. He wants us to have Christian family living. Yesterday we learned something about the husband and wife.

What must be true of both husband and wife in order for them to have a Christian marriage and home?

3. Both husband and wife must be Christians. Today we want to add another important thing.

In order for them to have a Christian marriage and home, both husband and wife must have good fellowship with God.

Even Christians can be discouraged by an unhappy marriage. If a Christian is selfish or angry, he has trouble living with another. If a Christian speaks sinful words or obeys temptations to adultery, the marriage has problems.

What does the Bible call anger, selfishness, and adultery?

4. The Bible calls these things sin. Sin always spoils the peace and blessing of marriage. Good fellowship with God helps a husband and wife turn from sin. So there are two things which must be true of husband and wife in Christian marriage.

(1) Both husband and wife must be Christians.

(2) Both must have good fellowship with God.

Can you think of a marriage that was spoiled by sin?

What happened?

5. It may be good for us to talk about this in class. Sin can spoil the peace and happiness of marriage. God does not want the blessings of marriage spoiled. He wants to help both husband and wife live right. They can act as Christians should act. God wants to give them strength to stay away from sins which spoil their marriage.

6. First, both husband and wife must be Christians. Then, good fellowship with God will help them have fellowship with each other. God will give them power to do right. Temptations to anger or selfishness or adultery will come. But God will help them overcome these temptations. They will get peace and blessing from their Christian marriage.

Take your Bible now and read 1 John 1:5 to 7. In Christian marriage what should both husband and wife have with God?

7. Both must have good fellowship with God. Their fellowship with God will give them spiritual strength. They will stay away from sin. They will stay away from fighting and lying. They will have good fellowship with each other.

What will help a husband and wife have good fellowship with each other?

8. Good fellowship with God gives us good fellowship with each other. God helps us keep away from sin.

Mrs Joseph was a Christian but she liked her own way. She was not in good fellowship with God. She wanted a new dress, but the family was short of money. At this time they needed all their money for school fees and farming. One day Mrs. Joseph was sent to sell some potatoes. She got a good price for them. She knew she should give all this to her husband, but she wanted her own way. She did not ask God to help her do right. Instead she bought a new dress. Of course her husband was angry with her. Mrs. Joseph was not in good fellowship with God or with her husband.

What kept Mrs. Joseph from having good home life?

9. She did not have good fellowship with God. She was selfish and caused trouble. There are two things needed for a husband and wife to have a Christian marriage.

- (1) Both husband and wife must be Christians.
- (2) Both must have good fellowship with God.

10. She lacked good fellowship with God. Many people give up good fellowship with God. They do this to get things which they think they need. This brings trouble.

Having enough money is good, and God does promise to meet our needs. But some people want more and more money. They disobey God to get it. Their good fellowship with God is gone. They stop trusting God. This harms their marriage and home life. God no longer rules their lives. He can no longer give his peace and blessings of fellowship. Trouble soon enters the home.

12. Their home life soon has trouble. It is spoiled. Even a marriage which began well may turn into fighting. Trouble will come if husband and wife leave their good fellowship with God.

13. To have good fellowship with God is more important. He helps you have joy and peace with others. He can bless you and give you all you need. Remember what Jesus said.

Matthew 6:33:

But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things shall be yours as well.

14. He gives us all these things. This means all the things we need. Each married person should remember this. Each must be careful to keep good fellowship with God. Only then will they be able to have good fellowship with each other.

4. He should leave his father and mother. He should cleave to his wife. They should become one flesh. Today we are thinking about the first two parts of a good marriage.

- (1) They must leave their parents.
- (2) They must cleave to each other.

When two marry, they become something new. They become a new thing separate from other things. They hold to each other. They become a new family.

5. A man should leave. This leaving does not mean he must move his place of living away from his parents. It means that in his mind he sees he has begun something new. His wife is now the first one for him to care for. He must first think of their marriage and home life. We all know that a wife leaves her family when she marries. But the Bible tells the man to leave in some way too.

6. He should do this to his parents. This is because he has started a new family. A man may continue to live near his parents. They will still be able to give him good advice. He will still help them. But now his first oneness and faithfulness are with his wife. He must cleave to his wife. To cleave means he must stick to her or stay with her.

8. Cleave means to stick to, or stay with, or be bound together. The husband should see that he and his wife stick together. But the husband and wife continue to honour their parents. They continue to love their parents. They help and care for them as they are able. But when two people marry, they separate in some ways from the rest of their family. They become one new family.

9. They must leave their parents. They must cleave together. Sometimes trouble can come into a marriage because of other family members. Others may bring in thoughts and commands which spoil the fellowship of husband and wife. Children and young people are commanded to obey their parents. Honor your father and your mother.

10. Honour means to respect and love them. Obey means to do what they tell you.

11. Let us talk about this together in class. A man should honour his father. But in his marriage perhaps there are times when he must think first of his wife. Remember that he must cleave to his wife.

Should a wife obey her mother against her husband's wishes?

12. Let us talk about this in class also. The wife is now one with her husband. She is no longer under her parents.

13. They must cleave to each other. Omolo and Sara were both Christians. They were married in the church. After a time Omolo's mother began to say bad things about Sara. Omolo had trouble knowing what to do. He continued to show love and respect to his mother. He asked his mother to help his wife learn. But he did not let his mother's words turn him against his wife.

Who must be first with a married man? Is it his mother, his father, or his wife?

14. His wife should be first. No one should be allowed to separate the man from his wife. Perhaps another woman will try to tempt the man into sin.

How should a husband treat one who tries to separate him from his wife?

15. He must refuse that one. If a husband is tempted to commit adultery he must ask God's help to refuse. We remember that in Christian family living, both husband and wife must be Christians. Both must have good fellowship with God. As they fellowship with God, he gives them strength. He gives them wisdom so they honour their parents even as they leave them. He gives them love for each other. He gives them strength to cleave to each other.

Becoming one flesh has many good meanings. One meaning is about their bodies. When a man and woman are married, they can have sex acts together. God created them male and female to be joined together in body.

Hebrews 13:4:

Let marriage be held in honor among all, and let the marriage bed be undefiled (or right); for God will judge the immoral and adulterous.

Do you think that husband and wife should enjoy becoming one in sex acts?

5. God wants married people to enjoy marriage. His word says we should hold marriage as honourable. We should think of the marriage bed as good. Sex acts in marriage were planned by God. Sex acts are sin only when they are done by two who are not married to each other.

Having sex acts is one way that a husband and wife can become what?

6. They can become one. Being one has many good meanings. It means the oneness of body in sex. It also means oneness in thoughts and feelings. It means oneness in daily life. Genesis 2:24 tells us three things that are needed to complete a marriage.

- (1) They must leave their parents.
- (2) They must cleave to each other.
- (3) They must become one.

What two people must do these things?

7. The husband and wife must do them. When two people marry, they become a new thing. God joins them together to become one. They can enjoy their oneness. They should have oneness of body in sex acts. They should share their thoughts and feelings. They should share some of life's daily actions. One of the greatest blessings of marriage is having someone you can trust completely. With this person you can share thoughts and feelings without being afraid. Think about this. Whom did God give to Adam so he could share daily life?

8. God gave him Eve. God saw that Adam was lonely and gave him a helper fit for him. Eve was with him every day. They shared oneness in body and thoughts. This one person, Eve, was enough. God could have given Adam more wives if this had been his will. But more wives would have spoiled the special oneness between the two.

When two marry, what do they become? _____

9. When two marry, they become one. Because they are one, they are not to divorce each other. They must be one as long as they both live. This is what Jesus said about divorce.

Mark 10:7-9:

‘For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.’ So they are no longer two but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man put asunder (or cut apart).

Who joins two people together in marriage? _____

10. God does this. God has joined you and your husband or wife together. In a special way you two are one before him.

Jesus spoke his words about divorce to answer a question. The Pharisees had asked Jesus if a man could divorce his wife. Jesus said that what God has joined together, man should not put apart.

From these words of Jesus, what should married people not do? _____

11. They should not divorce. They are made one by God. The two become one even if their oneness does not bring children. Some people think that you must have children to make a marriage complete. But the Bible does not teach this. Children are a blessing from God, but they do not make a marriage. They are only one blessing of marriage.
