The theme which ties together these five epistles (often called Jewish Christian writings) is the suffering of the recipients. The purpose of each author was to encourage Christians whose faith was being tested by focusing attention on the eternal hope. Even where physical persecution is not a threat for present-day Christians, a subtle form of spiritual and mental persecution by unbelievers continues. Thus, a study of these books is always pertinent.
